

# **Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990**

## **Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years, on March 31, 2018**

### **Introduction**

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under 28 U.S.C. § 476, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with the policy of the Judicial Conference of the United States, this report also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months (Rpt. of Proc. of JCUS, Mar. 10, 1998, at 11) and Social Security appeals pending more than six months (Rpt. of Proc. of JCUS, Sept. 15, 1998, at 63). The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

The CJRA report is prepared through the use of the Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) system. As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeals are reported in a standardized and consistent fashion.

Appendix A provides data for each district judge and magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending more than three years, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeals pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is "pending"; Appendix B lists these definitions.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, *A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for More Than Six Months, Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, and Social Security Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months*, that provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the district courts. This document is available to the public through the district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, the AO, and the Federal Judiciary website [www.uscourts.gov](http://www.uscourts.gov).

### **Report Findings**

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a "snapshot" of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months, and Social Security appeals pending more than six months on March 31, 2018. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters

pending on March 31, 2018, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Therefore, persons using reports of this type should take into account the state of change in the district courts' pending caseloads. Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors, including vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court's caseload.

## **Methodology**

This national report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF system. Each district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeals. Judges use status codes to provide reasons for delays in these matters (see Appendix C). The nature of suit codes for types of civil litigation appear in Appendix D. More specific information about cases pending, motions pending, bench trials submitted, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeals pending on September 30, 2017, and March 31, 2018, appears in Tables 1-4.

## **Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, Social Security Appeals and Civil Cases Pending, on March 31, 2018**

**Motions.** The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges increased 2 percent (up 128 motions) from 5,222 on September 30, 2017, to 5,350 on March 31, 2018. Ninety-three percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and seven percent were before magistrate judges.

For this CJRA report, eight circuits reported increases in pending motions, and four circuits reported decreases. The largest growth in pending motions occurred in the Third Circuit (up 116 motions), Tenth Circuit (up 86 motions), and Ninth Circuit (up 47 motions). In the Third Circuit, the Virgin Islands reported 47 more pending motions in many types of civil cases. In the Tenth Circuit, the Northern District of Oklahoma reported 61 more pending motions, also in many types of civil cases. In the Ninth Circuit, the District of Oregon reported 46 more motions, also in many types of civil cases.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions.* District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate primary reasons for delays for each of the 5,350 pending motions reported for March 31, 2018. The status codes cited most often were opinion/decision in draft (1,609 motions), complexity of case (1,123 motions), heavy criminal and civil caseload (799 motions), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (723 motions), referred to magistrate judge (361 motions), recently received from magistrate judge on recommendation (294 motions), and hearing on motion necessary (289 motions).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions.* The primary nature of suit codes provided most often by district courts for pending motions were civil rights (1,243 motions), prisoner petitions (1,034 motions), contract (726 motions), labor (330 motions), other statutory actions (302 motions), and intellectual property rights (259 motions).

**Bench Trials.** The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges increased from 57 to 63 on March 31, 2018. Eighty-seven percent of all bench trials submitted were before district judges, and 13 percent were before magistrate judges. Five of the 12 circuits reported growth in pending bench trials, 4 circuits had reductions in pending bench trials, and the totals for 3 circuits remained unchanged.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials.* District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate the primary reasons for delays for each of the 63 pending bench trials reported for March 31, 2018. The status codes cited most often were opinion/decision in draft (29 trials), complexity of case (15 trials), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (12 trials), heavy criminal and civil caseload (7 trials), parties given additional time to file supplemental briefs (7 trials), and awaiting materials (6 trials).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials.* The primary nature of suit codes provided most often for pending bench trials were contract (19 trials), civil rights (8 trials), prisoner petitions (8 trials), labor (6 trials), real property (4 trials), and other statutory actions (4 trials).

**Bankruptcy Appeals.** Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months decreased 12 percent from 164 on September 30, 2017, to 145 on March 31, 2018. All pending bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Reductions occurred in 5 of the 12 circuits, 3 circuits had increases, and totals in 4 circuits remained unchanged. Four circuits accounted for 83 percent of all pending bankruptcy appeals: the Ninth Circuit (40 appeals), Third Circuit (29 appeals), Fifth Circuit (28 appeals), and Second Circuit (24 appeals).

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals.* District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for each of the 145 pending bankruptcy appeals reported for March 31, 2018. The status codes cited most often

were opinion/decision in draft (39 appeals), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (31 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (30 appeals), awaiting materials (19 appeals), complexity of case (16 appeals), and settlement pending (7 appeals).

**Social Security Appeals.** Social Security appeals pending more than six months grew 4 percent (up 34 appeals) from 786 on September 30, 2017, to 820 on March 31, 2018. District judges reported 81 percent of these appeals; magistrate judges reported 19 percent. Seven of the 12 circuits reported increases, 4 had decreases, and 1 reported that its total remained unchanged. The largest growth in pending Social Security appeals occurred in the Third Circuit (up 18 appeals), Seventh Circuit (up 16 appeals), Second Circuit (up 9 appeals), and Eleventh Circuit (up 8 appeals).

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeals.* District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for all 820 pending Social Security appeals reported for March 31, 2018. The status codes cited most often were referred to magistrate judge (242 appeals), opinion/decision in draft (156 appeals), heavy criminal and civil caseload (139 cases), voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (113 appeals), demand on criminal docket (64 appeals), decided after the end of reporting period (50 appeals), and recently received from the magistrate judge on recommendation (50 appeals).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeals.* Fifty-three percent of pending Social Security appeals (438 appeals) involved disability insurance, and forty-three percent (349 appeals) involved supplemental security income.

**Civil Cases.** The number of civil cases pending more than three years declined 17 percent (down 6,298 cases) from 37,973 on September 30, 2017, to 31,675 on March 31, 2018. District judges reported 99 percent of all pending three-year-old cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 1 percent. Three-year-old cases decreased in 3 of the 12 circuits, increased in 8 circuits, and remained unchanged in 1 circuit. The

largest reduction occurred in the Fourth Circuit, which had 8,347 fewer pending cases. The Southern District of West Virginia, which had a decrease of 8,340 pending cases, terminated a substantial amount of multidistrict litigation involving pelvic support system products. The second-largest reduction occurred in the Eleventh Circuit, which had 75 fewer pending cases. The Northern District of Georgia had 79 fewer pending cases after it terminated product liability cases related to multidistrict litigation involving hip implants.

*Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Civil Cases.* District courts provided one or more status codes to indicate reasons for delays for all 31,675 civil cases reported for March 31, 2018. The status codes cited most often were multidistrict litigation (24,241 cases), settlement pending (3,570 cases), complexity of case (1,823 cases), extensive discovery involved (968 cases), awaiting materials (965 cases), trial scheduled (910 cases), referred to magistrate judge (859 cases), set for status conference (778 cases), and opinion/decision in draft (738 cases).

*Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Civil Cases.* The primary nature of suit codes given most often by district courts for pending civil cases were personal injury/product liability (15,373 cases), health care/pharmaceutical (5,336 cases), prisoner petitions (2,067 petitions), civil rights (1,356 cases), contract (988 cases), other statutory actions (918 cases), environmental matters (834), and other personal property damage (795 cases).

## Appendix B. Definitions

All active and senior district court judges, as well as all full-time and part-time magistrate judges, must report pending matters. Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

- With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed originally. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.
- This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Order Number 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

**Motions Pending More Than Six Months.** The Civil Justice Reform Act (CJRA) mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion is referred to a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge must file a report and make a recommendation for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending, or the motion shall be reported as pending for both the district judge and the magistrate judge.

**Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months.** The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted more than six months.

**Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months.** In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending more than six months. However, pursuant to recent revisions to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure that became effective in December 2014, bankruptcy clerks must now "promptly" docket the bankruptcy notice of appeal in the district court (see Bankruptcy Rule 8003). This change results in the pending date occurring before the bankruptcy clerk transmits to the district clerk either the complete record or notice that the record is available electroni-

cally. In addition, the time for filing principal appellate briefs and briefs in cross-appeals was extended, making 60 days insufficient to account for the necessary briefs (see Bankruptcy Rules 8016 and 8018). On recommendation of the Committee on Court Administration and Case Management, the Conference amended the reporting requirements so that appeals from a bankruptcy court to a district court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 158 are deemed pending 120 days after docketing of the bankruptcy clerk's transmission of the record or notice that the record is available electronically with the district court.

**Social Security Appeals Pending More Than Six Months.** In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such a case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending more than six months.

**Cases Pending More Than Three Years.** The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending more than three years.
