Subject Time Computation

I would be in favor of leaving the time computation as is. Unless the time for filing an appeal is made the same as in civil matters (30 days), a deadline of 14 days is as likely to catch the non-bankruptcy practitioner off-guard as 10 days. And, in light of the universally acknowledged benefit of prompt final dispositions in bankruptcy cases, I certainly would not favor 30 days.
