Subject Proposed Rule 56 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure

I strongly discourage the proposed rule requiring the moving party to list the undisputed facts in separate **"numbered"** paragraphs, and the opposing party to respond to the separate numbered paragraphs. I have had experience with such a rule and you would be surprised how many attorneys cannot count . **Separate paragraphs** may be o.k., but numbering is not workable.
