It seems to me that there is an error in the new 341 form for corporate debtors. Item #8 sets a deadline to file a complaint objecting to the dischargeability of certain debts. Those debts are spelled out in Section 1141(d)(6)(A) of the Bankruptcy Code. There is no reason to have this deadline/section on this form, because the debts are not dischargeable in corporate chapter 11s. See Sec. 1141(d)(6)(A).
