

Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990

Report of Motions Pending More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted More Than Six Months, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months, Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months, and Civil Cases Pending More Than Three Years on March 31, 2005

Introduction

The Civil Justice Reform Act of 1990 (CJRA) requires the Director of the Administrative Office of the United States Courts (AO), under Section 476 of Title 28, to prepare a semiannual report showing, by U.S. district judge and magistrate judge, all motions pending more than six months, all bench trials that have remained undecided more than six months, and all civil cases pending more than three years. The reporting requirements under the CJRA are designed to help reduce both costs and delays in civil litigation in the district courts. The information also may be used to evaluate demands on the district courts' resources.

This is the 28th semiannual report prepared pursuant to the CJRA that shows all motions in civil cases pending more than six months, civil bench trials submitted more than six months, and civil cases pending more than three years. In accordance with 1998 Judicial Conference mandates, this report now also presents data on bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months.

The CJRA report is prepared primarily by automated means, mostly through the use of the Integrated Case Management System/CJRA Statistical Reporting Program (ICMS/CJRA) and the Case Management/Electronic Case Files System (CM/ECF). As a result, pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases are being reported in a standardized and consistent fashion, and all judges using these systems have the most accurate tools to help them prepare semiannual reports.

For the CJRA report for March 31, 2005, a total of 93 of the 94 U.S. district courts used the AO's national ICMS/CJRA, CM/ECF, or simulations of these systems, to report all pending civil matters; one district court used a combination of manual and personal computer-based procedures to report its matters.

Appendix A provides data for each U.S. district judge and U.S. magistrate judge on motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending. The CJRA requires the AO Director to establish uniform standards for determining when a motion, bench trial, case, or bankruptcy appeal is "pending"; Appendix B lists these definitions. Status codes for motions pending, bench trials submitted, cases pending, bankruptcy appeals pending, and Social Security appeal cases pending appear in Appendix C. A list of nature of suit codes used in civil litigation appears in Appendix D.

Along with the semiannual consolidated national report, the AO prepares a supplemental report, *A Report on Motions Pending for More Than Six Months, Bench Trials Submitted for*

More Than Six Months, Civil Cases Pending Three Years or More, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending for More Than Six Months, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on March 31, 2005, which provides detailed information regarding the individual cases, motions, bench trials, and appeals pending in the U.S. district courts. This document is available to the public through the U.S. district courts, the executive offices of the U.S. courts of appeals, and the AO.

Report Findings

The information in this report presents what may best be described as a “snapshot” of motions pending more than six months, bench trials submitted more than six months, civil cases pending more than three years, and bankruptcy appeals and Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months on March 31, 2005. District judge and magistrate judge caseloads change constantly, so many of the matters pending on March 31, 2005, have since been decided or transferred to other judges. Those using reports of this type thus should take into account the state of change in the district courts’ pending caseloads.

Although the information provided in this report pertains to the pending civil caseload of district judges and magistrate judges, readers should take into consideration the overall case processing demands placed on the courts by both civil and criminal matters. An accurate assessment of the demands placed on the district courts also requires consideration of numerous factors such as vacant judgeships and the effects of all cases making up each court’s caseload.

Methodology

The CJRA national report is designed to place special emphasis on detailed analyses that are extracted from the national CM/ECF and ICMS/CJRA systems or obtained by other automated means. Each U.S. district court is required to analyze the reasons for delays in disposing of pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases. Judges may use numerous status codes to explain their reasons for delays in these matters. Currently, 30 such status codes are available for CJRA statistical reporting. More specific information about motions pending, bench trials submitted, and cases pending on September 30, 2004, and March 31, 2005, appears in Tables 1, 2, and 3. Figures 1 and 2 illustrate reasons for delay for pending motions, bench trials, three-year-old cases, bankruptcy appeals, and Social Security appeal cases attributed to district judges and magistrate judges during these reporting periods.

Numbers of Motions Pending, Bench Trials Submitted, Cases Pending, Bankruptcy Appeals Pending, and Social Security Appeal Cases Pending on March 31, 2005.

Motions. The total number of motions pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges fell 5 percent (down 420 motions) from 8,882 on September 30, 2004, to 8,462 on March 31, 2005. Pending motions for district judges dropped 6 percent to 7,622 (down 489 motions) from the total for September 30, 2004. However, 840 referrals of motions (up 69 motions) were made to magistrate judges from

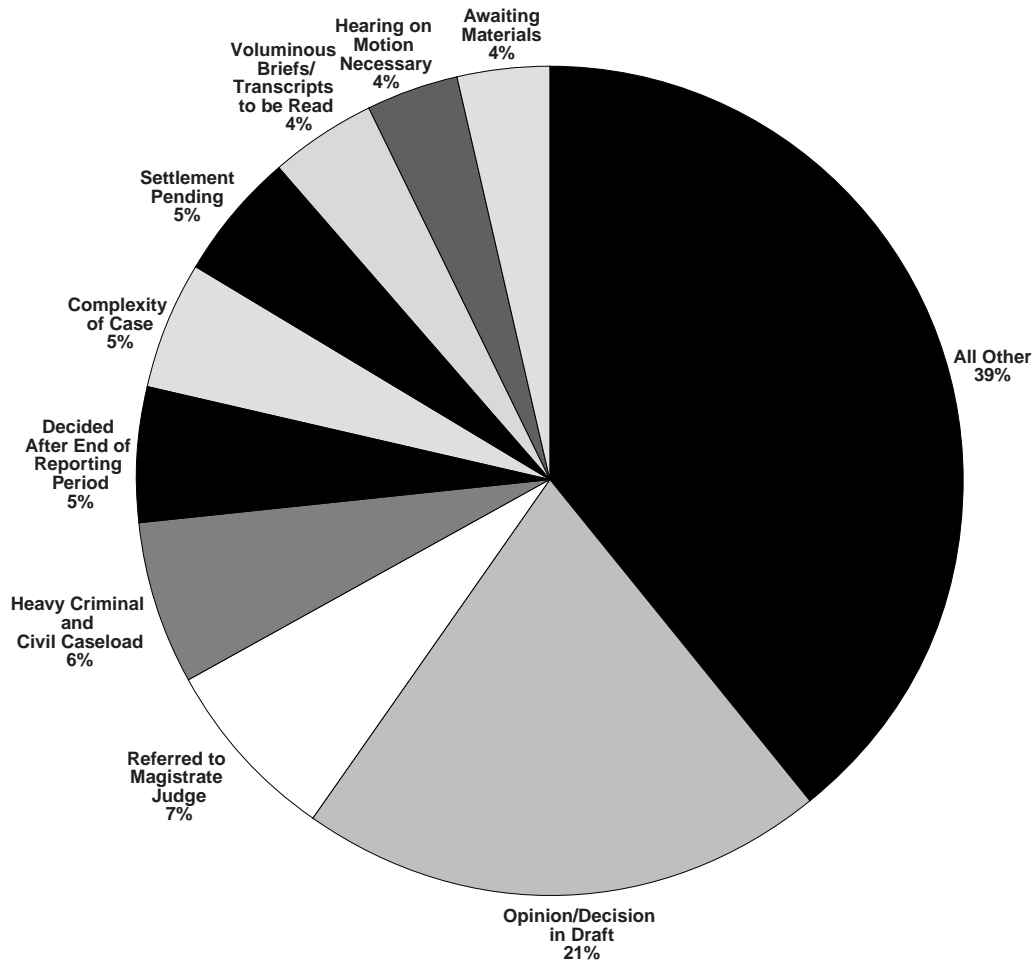
district judges. Ninety percent of all motions pending were before district judges, and 10 percent were before magistrate judges. This is the third consecutive CJRA reporting period in which pending motions have declined.

For the March 31, 2005, CJRA report, seven circuits reported decreases in pending motions, and five circuits reported increases. The most significant declines occurred in the Second Circuit (down 278 motions), the Fifth Circuit (down 167 motions), and the Sixth Circuit (down 145 motions). Judges in the District of Connecticut (down 111 motions) were most responsible for the Second Circuit's overall decline in motions. In the Fifth Circuit, a single judge in the Southern District of Mississippi disposed of more than 130 motions related to contracts and personal injury/product liability. In the Sixth Circuit, seven of the nine district courts reported fewer motions than they had for the previous reporting period.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Motions. District courts provided status codes for delays for each of the 8,462 motions reported on March 31, 2005 (see Appendix C). The majority of these codes (61 percent) were in the following nine categories: opinion/decision in draft (1,777 motions); referred to a magistrate judge (612 motions); heavy criminal and civil caseload (531 motions); complexity of case (464 motions); settlement pending (431); decided after the end of the reporting period (425 motions); awaiting materials (345 motions); hearing on motion necessary (310 motions); and voluminous briefs/transcripts to be read (295 motions).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Motions. The majority of the nature of suit codes provided by district courts for pending motions for March 31, 2005, were for the following seven groupings of civil cases: civil rights (2,003 motions); prisoner petitions (1,387 motions); contracts (1,110 motions); personal injury (682 motions); securities and

commodities exchange (646); labor suits (602 motions); and intellectual property rights (470 motions).

Bench Trials. The total number of bench trials pending more than six months for all district judges and magistrate judges increased by 8 from 78 on September 30, 2004, to 85 on March 31, 2005. Of these bench trials, district judges reported 86 percent (74 bench trials), and magistrate judges reported 14 percent (12 bench trials). The only circuits reporting 10 or more pending bench trials were the Second Circuit (12 trials), Third Circuit (12 trials), and First Circuit (11 trials), and the Sixth Circuit (10 trials).

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bench Trials. The only status code provided more than twice to indicate reasons for delays in pending bench trials on March 31, 2005, was opinion in draft (36 trials).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Bench Trials. District courts provided nature of suit codes for each of the 85 pending bench trials. Seventy-seven percent of these codes were related to contract actions (26 trials), personal injury (14 trials), civil rights cases (9 trials), labor suits (11 trials), or patent cases (6 trials).

Three-Year-Old Cases. The number of civil cases pending more than three years rose 1 percent (up 244 cases) from 18,696 on September 30, 2004, to 18,953 on March 31, 2005. District judges reported 98 percent of all pending three-year-old cases; magis-

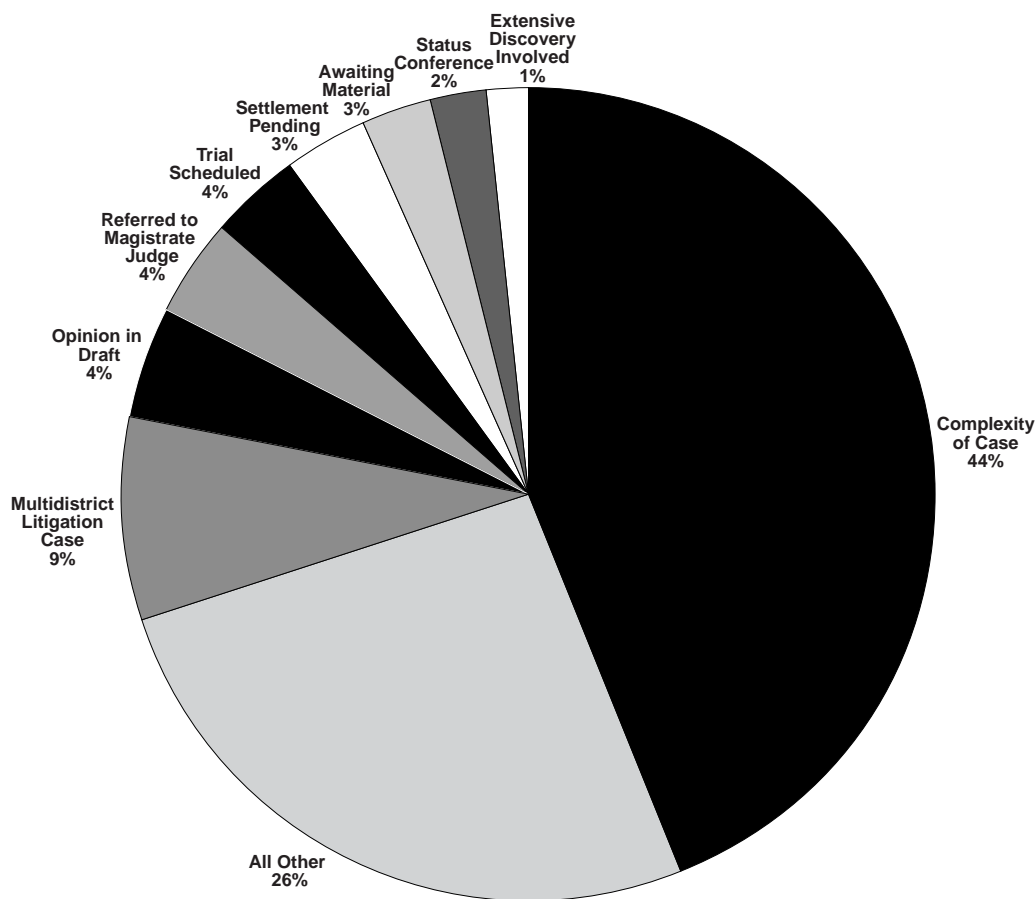
trate judges reported the remaining 2 percent. The rise in three-year-old cases resulted from increases in 9 of the 12 circuits. However, the only numerical increase greater than 100 cases occurred in the Second Circuit (up 166 cases). The remaining eight circuits with increases in three-year-old cases reported an average of 32 cases per circuit. Forty-two percent of all three-year-old cases pending on March 31, 2005 (more than 7,800), involved oil refinery explosions in the Middle District of Louisiana; these cases currently are assigned to a judge pending settlement activity.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. District courts provided status codes in all 18,953 cases to indicate the reasons for delays in three-year-old cases. The majority of status codes used (74 percent) indicated the following nine categories: complexity of case (8,330 cases); multidistrict litigation case (1,563 cases); referred to magistrate judge (831 cases); trial scheduled (749 cases); opinion in draft (663 cases); settlement pending (616 cases); awaiting materials (551 cases); set for status conference (437 cases); and extensive discovery involved (264 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes In Pending Three-Year-Old Cases. Most of the nature of suit codes used for the 18,953 pending three-year-old cases fell into the following eight groupings: personal injury (9,564 cases); prisoner petitions (2,258 petitions); civil rights (1,659 cases); securities and commodities exchange (1,041); land condemnation (1,024 cases); contracts (993 cases); intellectual property (382 cases); and labor cases (345 cases).

Bankruptcy Appeals. Bankruptcy appeals pending more than six months declined by 25 appeals on March 31, 2005, to 288. All bankruptcy appeals were reported by district judges. Eight circuits had decreases in bankruptcy appeals, and four circuits had increases. The following six circuits reported 89 percent (256 appeals) of all pending bankruptcy appeals: the Third Circuit (66 appeals), the Second Circuit (61 appeals), the Ninth Circuit

(55 appeals), the Eleventh Circuit (27 appeals), the Sixth Circuit (26 appeals), and the Fifth Circuit (21 appeals). The largest decline in pending bankruptcy appeals occurred in the Third Circuit, where appeals fell by 21.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Bankruptcy Appeals. District courts provided status codes for each of the 288 pending bankruptcy appeals to indicate reasons for delays. Forty-three percent of these codes fell into the following four categories: awaiting materials (48 appeals); opinion/decision in draft (41 appeals); complexity of case (18 appeals); and recently received from the calendar of another judge (16 appeals).

Social Security Appeal Cases. Social Security appeal cases pending more than six months dropped 8 percent (down 50 appeal cases) to 608 on March 31, 2005. District judges reported 75 percent of these appeal cases, and magistrate judges reported the remaining 25 percent. Eight circuits had declines, three circuits had increases, and the total for one circuit remained unchanged. The pending caseloads in the Second, Ninth, Third, and Fourth Circuits accounted for 76 percent of the national pending Social Security appeal caseload.

Primary Reasons for Delays in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. District courts provided status codes for all 608 pending Social Security appeal cases. Seventy-five percent of these codes fell into the following seven categories: referred to magistrate judge (134 cases); opinion/decision in draft (105 cases); heavy criminal and civil caseload (70 cases);

awaiting materials (60 cases); recently received from the calendar of another judge (36 cases); voluminous brief/transcripts to be read (26 cases); and decided after the end of the reporting period (26 cases).

Primary Nature of Suit Codes in Pending Social Security Appeal Cases. Of all nature of suit codes provided for Social Security appeal cases, 94 percent (574 cases) were related to disability insurance or supplemental security income.

Appendix B. Definitions

All active and senior district court judges, as well as all full-time and part-time magistrate judges, must report pending matters. Detailed guidelines for making reports under the CJRA on pending motions, bench trials, and cases appear in the AO's Guide to Judiciary Policies and Procedures (see Volume III-A (Judges Manual), Chapter IV of Section D and Volume XI (Statistics Manual)). Several issues relevant to the reporting of cases pending for more than three years include the following.

- With respect to cases pending for more than three years that have been assigned to district judges and magistrate judges from outside the districts where the cases originated, such cases are included in the totals for the districts where they were filed initially. Sometimes a block of cases or a class of cases that are similar in nature is assigned to a single judge. Such cases often require lengthy litigation when they involve complex issues and large numbers of parties.

- This report includes some asbestos cases. The Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation (MDL) authorized the transfer of most of the pending asbestos personal injury/product liability cases to the Eastern District of Pennsylvania under Order Number 875. Asbestos cases that have remained in the districts where they were filed originally or that were transferred back to the original districts are included in this report. However, those cases transferred according to MDL Docket 875 are excluded. All other MDL cases are included in this report.

Cases Pending More Than Three Years. The CJRA requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of cases pending more than three years in the district courts. A case becomes pending as of the date the case originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was reopened, whichever is later. If a case has not been disposed of within three years after its filing date or reopening date, the case shall be reported as pending for more than three years.

Motions Pending More Than Six Months. The CJRA mandates a report enumerating all motions that have been pending for six months or longer. A motion is a request made to a district judge or magistrate judge for an order, ruling, or similar determination. The opposing party has 30 days from the date of a motion's filing to respond to it. A motion becomes pending 30 days after the date it was filed or was referred to a magistrate judge, whichever is later. If no decision on a motion has been filed within six months after the date the motion became pending, and the motion has not been referred to a magistrate judge, the motion shall be reported as pending for more than six months before the presiding judge. If a motion is referred to a magistrate judge, the magistrate judge must file a report and make a recommendation for, or dispose of, the motion within six months after the date the motion became pending, or the motion shall be reported as pending for both the district judge and the magistrate judge.

Bench Trials Submitted More than Six Months. The CJRA requires the AO to prepare a report of bench trials submitted for more than six months. In a bench trial, the judge (rather than a jury) decides the facts of the case. A bench trial is considered to be submitted on the date the courtroom proceedings are concluded. If a judge fails to file an opinion within six months after a bench trial was submitted, the bench trial shall be reported as submitted for more than six months.

Bankruptcy Appeals Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the March 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of bankruptcy appeals pending for more than six months in the district courts. A bankruptcy appeal becomes pending as of the date the appeal originally was filed in the district court or the date the case was

reopened, whichever is later. If an appeal has not been disposed of within six months plus 60 days after its filing date or reopening date, the appeal shall be reported as pending for more than six months.

Social Security Appeal Cases Pending More Than Six Months. In accordance with an action of the September 1998 Judicial Conference, the CJRA now requires a report, by district judge and magistrate judge, of Social Security appeal cases pending for more than six months in the district courts. A Social Security appeal case becomes pending as of the date of the filing of the latest transcript in such case. If a case has not been disposed of within six months plus 120 days after its filing date, the case shall be reported as pending for more than six months.
