Subject Proposed Bankruptcy Rule Changes

Dear Rules Committee,

Please note my objection to the proposed rule changes requiring a debtor to provide more extensive documentation to Trustees. Requiring debtors to provide tax returns, paystubs and bank statements is unduly burdensome and will require unnecessary information when Trustees already have the ability to request this information either informally or by way of more extensive Rule 2004 examination. In my practice as primarily a debtors attorney, these documents are routinely provided to Standing Trustees upon request. These rule changes will be punitive against debtors who are already poor record keepers and who either are unemployed, poor or otherwise who do not have the ability to provide this information.
